

Town Charter Committee December 12, 2024



Committee met in HYBRID session at 6:30 p.m. at Abbot Hall, 188 Washington Street

The Chair called the meeting of December 12, 2024, to order.

Minutes. Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of November 14, 2024. Moved by Victor Wild, seconded by Tom Massaro. Boards/Commission/Committees. The following Departments/Boards/Commissions joined the Charter Committee for discussion and the opportunity to answer questions from the Committee regarding the current structure of their Department, Board or Commission, delivery of services, budget process and to allow for the opportunity to discuss any suggestions.

Town Clerk. Robin Michaud, Town Clerk, joined the Charter Committee in discussion. The Clerk is an elected position. Ms. Michaud reviewed Election and Registration processes and answered questions from the Committee.

School Committee. Jennifer Schaeffner, School Committee member, joined the Committee in discussion. While the School Committee is governed by State Regulations Ms. Schaeffner stated that the School Committee has an excellent relationship with the Finance Director, Finance Committee and Town Administrator.

Housing Authority. Jennifer Schaeffner and Terri Tauro, members of the Housing Authority joined the Committee in discussion. The Housing Authority is governed by Mass General Law and Ms. Schaeffner and Ms. Tauro stated that whenever possible the Housing Authority and the Town will coordinate support for each other.

The Committee discussed the various housing committees appointed by the Select Board and agreed to take a closer look at what the specific functions of these committees are.

Housekeeping items. Town Administrator is working on schedule Department Heads for future Charter Committee Meeting.

Charter Language Review. The Committee reviewed a draft outline of the Charter prepared by Sean Casey. Minor edits were made for consistency. Sean will continue to draft Charter Language. The Committee hopes to be ready to post draft Charter language to the website towards the end of January for residents to view and comment on at future public forums the Committee will be holding.

Public Comment. None. The Board discussed placement of public comment on the agenda.
