- Arts Festival, Crocker Park (Brian Wheeler)
 - No changes from past years
 - Already contacted Marblehead police to request two officers per night for detail with staggered shifts of 6p10p and 6:30p-10:30p
 - Load in Tues 07/02/24, then start on 07/04/24 with shows at 12p, 2p, 6p and 8p showtimes on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.
 - Planning to complete break down by around 3p on Sunday 07/07/24
 - Hoping to have Boy Scouts involved this year
 - o Tyson Miller will be new lighting director; used to intern with them
 - One band left to book
 - Brian highlighted new sound
 - Went to school for sound after complaints two years ago to learn how to control it better;
 reduced the effects of the sound on neighbors
 - Peter commented they have not had complaints in the past couple of years and commended Brian on their work
 - New secretary Ashley Hannaway
 - o Jaime Bloch requested to speak with Ashley to go over permit requirements for festival days
 - Karin made a motion to approve the days and times on flyer.
 - Unanimously approved
- Dog Park Stephen and Linda
 - Linda met with Ted Moore regarding gaining access to property for access road to dog park
 - Linda reports meeting went extremely well Ted gave permission
 - Will end up with more parking at dog park
 - They discussed specifications for size, angles, gate locations, etc.
 - Gave permission to take down trees on his property if necessary for access
 - Linda suggested group site visit on March 5, 2024
 - Rosanna asked Stephen about the depth of the stone dust
 - Peter will ask Becky Curran about this
 - Stephen noted organic lock stabilizer is used to hold stone dust together
 - Around 13,000 square feet total
 - Stephen noted they will privately fundraise for surfacing

- Beach Discussion
 - Matt Martin spoke with Town Administrator Thatcher Kezer Commission can raise rates for beaches without going to Town Meeting for approval from town
 - Debated dollar amount vs percentage to determine the portion the Commission keeps
 - Currently it is dollar amount

 - Cost = around \$13,000 total
 - Some handicap accessible
 - Lighter in weight; will be removed when storms expected
 - Motion to approve; unanimously approved
- Park employees are doing more cleanups with nicer weather
- John DiCicco has been working on equipment
- Trash 3x per week
- Still open position, search for candidates is ongoing
- Peter and Jaime met with Thatcher and Aleesha about the budget
 - Money for clerk & custodial services cut along with other line items
 - Can request again next year
 - o About \$58,000 cut from budget
- Vine St
 - o Need to get items up on Municibid
 - o Two boats?
 - Peter will talk to Jon Fobert about this
- Karin asked if we have all mowers needed for summer Peter confirmed yes
- Tree at Seaside on Jon Fobert's radar
 - He may come to Rec & Park Commission meeting for ideas on where to plant trees

Recreation Updates - Jaime Bloch

 - Large percentage returning, not a lot of hiring to do except sailing staff need more
