  - b. Board Vote-Designation of Winn Development Corporation to partner with the Marblehead Housing Authority to further explore the Development of Broughton Road.-A vote to allow the Executive Director to proceed with developing an MOU with Winn Development to move forward with a redevelopment project at Broughton Road.
  - c. Board Vote-Vendor Payment Bills for period ending July 31, 2024-a summary of the vendor payments made the previous month for the Board to review and ask questions/approve
  - d. Board Vote-Automatic Laundry Services Bid for Laundry Services to three Marblehead Housing Authority properties-Roads School, Powderhouse Court and Farrell Court. One Company submitted bid-Automatic Laundry Services.
