- Transfer station update
 - Ongoing concerns regarding the compactor crisis.

- Public Health Update
 - o Noted increase in pertussis cases, with discussion on vaccine efficacy and hesitancy.
 - o COVID-19 cases have significantly declined but remain as an endemic disease.
 - RSV and pneumonia cases are rising. RSV is not included in the Maven reporting system.
 - Suggestion to track RSV data separately with an asterisk indicating a different source.

4. Additional Business

- Discussion on the Board of Health's mission statement; a minor word change was approved.
- Review of past meeting minutes; concerns were raised about excessive detail, and revisions will be made to make them more concise.
- Discussion on the new transaction huts at the transfer station, which were acquired at a significantly reduced cost.
