July 10, 2024

The Chair called the meeting of July 10, 2024 to order. This meeting is being recorded.

GIFT TO TOWN. Portrait. Sally and Larry Sands appeared before the Board seeking to donate to the Town a portrait of Sally's great grandfather, Henry Florence Pitman, born in 1808 and died in 1885. He was a trustee of the Abbot Fund and the building committee, and his name is on the plaque outside the Select Board's office. He lived on Pleasant Street and a book has been written on the house that features a chapter about Henry Pitman, known as the 5th wealthiest person in the town at the time owning vast amounts of property throughout town. Motion made and seconded to accept, as a gift to the Town, a portrait of Henry Florence Pitman, and put in the care and custody of the Historical Commission. All in favor.

TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS. Foster Street. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Elizabeth Linn Torto for temporary parking restrictions on the right side of Foster Street to Harbor Avenue on Sunday, July 14, 2024 from 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. subject to approval from Police and Fire and police detail as needed. All in favor.

PERMISSION. Half Marathon, YuKan Sports. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Richard A. Morrell, YuKanRun, to hold a half marathon road race on Sunday, April 13, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. subject to receipt of the required Certificate of Insurance, naming the Town as additionally insured, and approval from the Marblehead Police, Fire, Recreation and Parks, School Department and police details as determined by Marblehead Police. No permanent markings are allowed on the streets and all temporary markings shall be removed at the conclusion of the event. The event will start and end at Marblehead High School. Portions of the event will benefit Marblehead Public Schools and the Council on Aging. All in favor.

PERMISSION. 5K Road Race. Marblehead Youth Hockey. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Lauren Cross Calabrese, Marblehead Youth

Hockey, to hold a 5K road race to benefit Marblehead Youth Hockey Association, on Sunday, September 22, 2024 at 8:00 a.m., subject to receipt of the required Certificate of Insurance, naming the Town as additionally insured, and approval from the Marblehead Police, Fire, Recreation and Parks, School Department and police details as determined by Marblehead Police. No permanent markings are allowed on the streets and all temporary markings shall be removed at the conclusion of the event. The event will start and end at Devereux Beach. All in favor.

CONTRACT. Carahsoft Technology Corp. Cloud Based Records Management. The Town Administrator and Fire Chief reviewed the contract for cloud-based records management. Motion made and seconded to award a contract between the Town and Carahsoft Technology Corporation, 11493 Sunset Hill Road, Suite 100, Reston, Virginia 20190 for Cloud-Based Records Management and Response Software for firefighting functions and emergency medical response management, in the amount of twenty-seven thousand five hundred twenty-five dollars and forty-five cents (\$27,525.45) and to authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. All in favor.

APPOINTMENT. Interim Veteran's Agent. Motion made and seconded to appoint Town Administrator, Thatcher Kezer, Interim Veteran's Agent. All in favor.

FY25 COASTAL RESILIENCE GRANT. Letter of Support. Motion made and seconded to send a letter of support regarding the FY25 Coastal Resilience grant application and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. All in favor.

OPEN MEETING LAW. Complaint. Motion made and seconded to delegate Town Counsel to response to the Open Meeting Law complaint filed by Patrick Higgins and Associates on June 28, 2024. All in favor.

ABBOT HALL. Permission To Use. Kearsarge Lodge. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Tim Shotmeyer, Noble Grand, Kearsarge Lodge, Swampscott, to use Abbot Hall auditorium on November 9, 2024 for a benefit concert subject the usual rules, regulations, fees and required Certificate of Insurance naming the Town of Marblehead as additionally insured. All in favor.

MINUTES. Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes from June 5, 2024 and June 12, 2024. 3 voted in favor, Mr. Fox abstained.

LICENSING. 1 Day Liquor License. Egypt House. Motion made to approve the request from Fr. Andrew, Egypt House, for a one-day liquor license on Thursday, August 15, 2024, 12:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. subject to the following conditions:

- Delivery of and receipt by the Licensing Authority of the required fee (\$50).
- Delivery of and receipt by the Licensing Authority of Proof that the alcohol will be purchased from an authorized source.
- Proof that the applicant can receive proper delivery; provide proper storage and disposal of all alcoholic beverages purchased all in accordance with the requirements of G. L. c. 138.

 Alcohol will be purchased from Marblehead Brewing Co. and Sheehan and Seaboard.

Moved by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Murray. On a polled vote the Board voted as follows: Mr. Fox, in favor; Mrs. Singer, in favor; Mr. Murray, in favor; Mrs. Noonan, in favor.

DISCUSSION. Harbors and Waters Board/Zoning Board of Appeals.

Harbors and Waters Board. The Board discussed annual re-appointments to the various Boards and Committee as it relates to possible reorganization of those boards. Mrs. Noonan said that both herself and Mr. Grader spoke with Gary Gregory, Chair of Harbors and Waters and said he was in favor of increasing the membership. The Board discussed various options related to membership numbers, composition and terms based on having looked at other towns to see how their Harbors and Waters Board are formed. The Board would like to review the Mission of the Harbors and Waters to better represent its current activities. The Chair will work with Gary Gregory and Town Administrator on a draft updated statement to bring to the Board at their next meeting. The following votes were taken:

Motion made and seconded to amend the Harbors and Waters Board from 5 Member/3 Alternates Board to 7 Members/0 Alternates to be effective upon the reappointment of the membership of the new board at a future meeting. All in favor.

Motion to amend the terms of the Harbors and Waters Board from 1 year to 3-year staggered terms as follows: 3 members for 3 year terms; 2 members for 2 year terms; 2 members for 1 year terms; effective upon the reappointment of the membership of the new board at a future meeting. All in favor.
