BUDGETS.

Police Department. Police Chief Robert Picariello appeared before the Board to present his proposed budgets for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$3,654,351.00 for Salaries, \$182,390.00 for Expense, \$5,000.00 for Indemnification of Officers, for a total operating budget of \$3,841,741.00. All in favor.

Animal Inspector. Motion made and seconded to approve \$2,400.00 for Salaries, for a total operating budget of \$2,400.00. All in favor.

Fire Department. Fire Chief Jason Gilliland appeared before the Board to present his proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$3,493,596.00 for Salaries, \$187,020.00 for Expense, \$5,000.00 for Fire Alarm Expense, for a total operating budget of \$3,685,616.00. 4 voted in favor, Mr. Christensen voted present.

Harbors and Waters Department. Mark Souza, Harbormaster, appeared before the Board to present his proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$377,066.00 for Salaries, \$402,515.00 for Expense, \$260,000.00 for Capital Outlays, for a total operating budget of \$1,039,581.00. All in favor.

Highway Department. Arthur Graves, Director of Public Works, appeared before the Board to present his proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$852,640.00 for Salaries, \$107,084.00 for Expense, \$48,750.00 for Rebuild/Maintain Streets and Sidewalks, \$100,000.00 for Snow Removal, for a total operating budget of \$1,108,474.00. All in favor.

Tree Department. Doug Gordon, Tree Warden, appeared before the Board to present his proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$279,007.00 for Salaries, \$51,578.00 for Expense, for a total operating budget of \$330,585.00. All in favor.

Veterans Services Department. David C. Rodgers, Veterans' Agent, appeared before the Board to present his proposed budgets for FY 2019 as follows:

Motion made and seconded to approve \$519,899.00 for Salaries, \$21,355.00 for Expense, \$6,000.00 for Local Travel, for a total operating budget of \$547,254.00. All in favor.

Public Buildings Department. Richard Baldacci, Building Commissioner, appeared before the Board to present the proposed Public Buildings budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$102,606.00 for Salaries, \$105,790.00 for Expense, \$400.00 for Local Travel, for a total operating budget of \$208,796.00. All in favor.

Council on Aging. Lisa Hooper, Director of the Council on Aging, appeared before the Board to present her proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$301,560.00 for Salaries, \$11,990.00 for Expense, for a total operating budget of \$313,550.00. All in favor.

Finance Department. Alison Nieto, Finance Director, appeared before the Board to present her proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$639,075.00 for Salaries, \$268,310.00 for Expense, \$4,150,000.00 for Maturing Debt, \$2,585,428.25 for Interest, \$690,000.00 for Medicare, \$13,116,584.00 for Group Insurance, \$79,524.00 for Non-Contributory Retirement for a total operating budget of \$21,528,921.25 All in favor.

Other Post-Employment Benefits. Alison Nieto, Finance Director, appeared before the Board to present her proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$350,000.00 for Other Post-Employment Benefits for a total operating budget of \$350,000.00. All in favor.

Workers Compensation. Alison Nieto, Finance Director, appeared before the Board to present her proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$382,169.00 for Workmen's Compensation, for a total operating budget of \$382,169.00. All in favor.

Selectmen's Department. John J. McGinn, Town Administrator, presented the proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$5,500.00 for Office Expenses, \$415,394.00 for Salaries, \$98,245.00 for Expense, \$21,000.00 for Zoning Board of Appeals Legal Services, \$15,000.00 for Training, \$2,000.00 for Out-of-State Travel, \$4,300.00 for Town Reports, \$54,500.00 for Audit of Accounts, \$128,820.00 for Street Lighting, \$475,888.00 for Other Insurance, \$110,770.00 for Salary Reserve, \$100,000.00 for Utility Reserve, \$533,544.00 for Energy Reserve for a total operating budget of \$1,964,961.00. All in favor.

Parking Clerk. John J. McGinn, Town Administrator, presented the proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$13,095.00 for Expense, for a total operating budget of \$13,095.00. All in favor.

Town Counsel. John J. McGinn, Town Administrator, presented the proposed budget for FY 2019. Motion made and seconded to approve \$2,000.00 for Salaries, \$81,575.00 for Expense, for a total operating budget of \$83,575.00. All in favor.

CONTRACT. Consultant. Town Administrator Search. Motion made and seconded to approve a contract with the Edward J. Collins, Jr. Center for Public Management at the University of Massachusetts, Boston, for ten thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$10,000) to assist in the search process for a new Town Administrator and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. All in favor.

MARBLEHEAD HISTORICAL COMMISSION. Revolving Fund. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Chris Johnston, Chairman, to reauthorize the Historical Commission Gift Shop Revolving Fund in the amount of \$15,000 for fiscal 2019 in accordance with Mass General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E ½.
